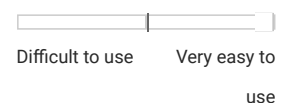
Great Shelter

I love this hammock!

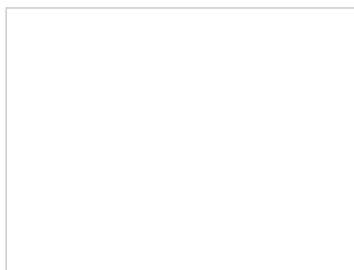

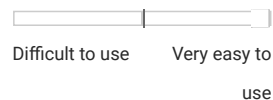

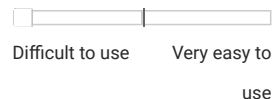

my favorite piece of camping gear

Man I feel cool whipping this out when everyone else is setting up their tents. I've been using the Scout Classic since 2016, which is the smaller version of this (I'm 5' 7", 130 lb. and frugal). In the beginning, I was intimidated by the default rope and tree strap setup and opted for third-party hammock straps and carabiners, which has made setup a breeze. But recently I've wanted to revert to the originally intended minimalist setup and ditch the unnecessary hardware. My comfort with camping has evolved over the years and I'm happy to have the Hennessy Hammock throughout.

The snakeskins are a must for me, I love not having to fold and stuff the hammock and can pack it in seconds while staying dry under the fly. I pack two tent stakes for tying down the rain fly close to the hammock body in bad weather. I haven't had the rain fly fail me as others have commented, but haven't used it in torrential monsoons either. I also pack a blue tarp that I place underneath the hammock for my pack and shoes, and just wrap them up in the case of rain.

I sleep cold so unfortunately hammock season is over by late fall. Even in summer I absolutely need a sleeping pad, I use a Thermarest Scout inflatable pad that's just the right size for insulating my shoulders and butt.

There's nothing more relaxing and cozier than gently swinging in this hammock after a long day's hike, dry and warm and shielded from mosquitoes. Though to another reviewer's point of feeling exposed, I've never felt more nervous than solo camping in this and hearing a buck rustling around and feeling like I was about to become a low-hanging pinata.

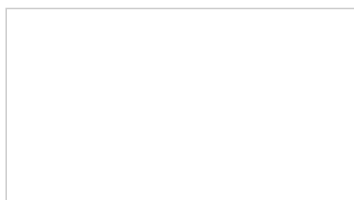

Hennessy's Expedition Asym almost perfect for wilderness canoe tripping - light, quick set up, weatherproof, uneven ground friendly, very comfortable for a week - but three things need to be adapted to: 1) must find some other place to put gear you don't hang, 2) lowers sleeping bag warmth because no insulation below, and 3) impossible to change clothing within, unless you are a contortionist. Still, much better than a tent. Also bought Explorer Deluxe; 190# dad in Explorer, daughter in Expedition. Tried both and wished had only bought Expedition - Explorer Deluxe bigger/deeper than necessary for me. Expedition was so comfortable my daughter slept it in it at home for the month before returning to college. Webbing straps (included) essential to have zero impact on trees.

Great Shelter System

I just recently purchased this hammock system for a Memorial Day trip to the ADKs and I just loved how it performed. It took a bit of getting used to with knowing how to set it up, take it down, and pack it, but once you get the hang of it camp clean up is effortless leaving you with more time on the trail.

Now that I have this hammock I'm going hiking more and simply looking for other areas to use it in. It's great to take for day hikes (set it up for a short nap/rest), or family picnics/ backyard camping. A couple things you need to know about this sleeping system though.

Under draft is a real concern so make sure you have a pad or underquilt with this system or the heat will completely leave you and you will be left cold at night. I had a 15 degree bag in 45 degree sleep temps and my feet accidentally came off my pad and they were cold. It's easily avoidable, but important to know.

Sleep diagonal and not with the curve of the hammock. These and other asymmetrical hammocks are meant to be sleep in diagonally so that you actually sleep flat and not curved like a banana. This will keep tension off your knees and neck giving you a much more comfortable sleep.

Other than that when set up properly you stay warm and dry in this excellent sleep system.

Tarp too small for tropical winds and rain.

TL;DR: Great package, everything you need. Suspension system basic, but usable with knots. Tarp too small for strong tropical

winds with rain.

I purchased this hammock to use in the Florida Keys. First off, the package does indeed include everything you need to start hammocking. I did look up a video or two to learn how to tie up the ropes though, as this does not come with the easier hook and loop or carabiner type suspension systems. It's just a rope that ties to a tree strap with loops on each end.

For the first night it was great. The bug net kept the bugs out and it was definitely comfortable. I would recommend a sleeping pad or underquilt if it's windy and a mild temperature.

Unfortunately, where it fell short, was the tarp. While the tarp system is very slick; easily attaching and tensioning against the ridge line, it's just too darn small for heavy tropical winds and rain. When rain starts slanting in 30 mph+ winds water starts to make its way in. It wasn't flooding in, but over the course of an hour or so the whole side of the hammock was wetted. This was after tensioning the guy lines as much as I humanely could and affixing them to large landscaping blocks.

I'll likely buy a hammock again in the future, but ensuring I have a larger tarp to pair with it.

Fast, comfortable, reliable, COMFORTABLE.

This is like a 4.8 out of 5 rating. The CONs are pretty minimal.

My team and I used these hammocks in a 3-week trek through the mountains of Panama. They performed beautifully. At 6'1" and 200 lbs, I probably could have bumped up to a slightly larger model, but managed to be elevated, comfortable and dry the entire time.

PRO:

- Can lay flat quickly, easily, and even sleep on your side (a little easier in a slight fetal position)
- Sets up quick (see below)
- One piece. This is HUGE if you've used other systems like the ENO with a separate bug net. Set one of these up in the rain or with a hoard of biting insects and you'll see what I mean.
- Bug net sits well away from your face/arms/knees (again, with the ENO this is against your body and tenacious bugs can still bite while you sleep).

-Ventilates well, you won't feel like a drive-thru taco the whole night

-Integrated gear stowage on the topline (key for headlamp, kindle, even a spare blanket)

CON:

-The main lines have no attaching hardware, which means you need to tie them off to the straps. They are also SUUUUPER stretchy, so for longer spans you really need to lean on them to get them taught. HIGHLY recommend terminating these in figure-8 loops near the hammock and connecting with a whoopie sling system. This cuts down setup time to a few minutes tops.

-You'll need tent stakes to secure the rain fly, which is small enough that it needs to be positioned juuust right to avoid getting your toes or nose wet. Really not that big a deal, just a heads up. Also recommend using a tensioning device or knot for these tie downs to speed the process up more.

These are a staple for the team now and I'm thinking of buying a personal model for my own off-work use. I recommend setting this up with a little less tension than you might with other hammock tents to best make use of the assymetric aspect. A few test setups and lying in it for a while and you'll find the sweet spot and can set it by eye.
