

It's smaller and lighter than it's big brother the Strike Force but it doesn't spark anywhere near as hot. It's still better than many of the others I've tried, though. If you're an ultralight hiker, it'll work, but if you really want a survival fire starter, carry a couple extra ounces and get the Strike Force. That one just plain works.

Actually, the problem isn't the rod. It's in cheap, soft steel they used. If you use a knife instead, you can get a far stronger spark. The good steel from the Strike Force will also get a strong spark with the Spark Force. They tried to save a nickle and ruined a great product.

### It needs a ferro rod but, is functional.

This tool has good and bad aspects. I have bought one these ferro rod & striker combo's before. I bought this one to use on a neck chain. It is not only small enough but, main feature for me is it is self contained and sheltered by it's case from the corrosive effects of the salt in perspiration. Perspiration will cause a ferro rod to rust and become pitted. The two parts are solidly locked together and I use the lanyard to pul/ force them apart.

Another plus is the highly visible orange color. Starting a fire at dusk or during difficult conditions it is

pretty easy to mix dark colored equipment such as a ferro rod with the natural debris present. This can happen even in best conditions.

This rod and striker individually are small and aukward to use. It is not a big spark generator making it necessary to get up close and personal with the tinder. The tinder must be well prepared with positioning of the ferro rod so not to strike your knuckle with each attempt. I'll try different technics but haven't found

This has exceeded my expectations and is ideal for what I wanted - something to carry around in my pocket much of the time. It's compact (about the size of a disposable lighter) and the lid with integrated striker means it doesn't get tangled up or interfere with other things. It's orange so I can find it more easily when I leave it somewhere. Oh, and it produces decent sparks - way better than 'just about good enough'. I don't think it replaces the 'Light My Fire Army' (or other good quality larger models) but if I found myself away somewhere with only this one, it would be no disaster

The striker, as expected, is nothing to write home about, but works well enough, for certain. I do wonder how long it would last if only the integrated striker were used, but I'll probably only use that when I don't have something else handy.

The biggest problem so far has been thinking it isn't in my pocket, when in fact, it is. I may well buy another one or two.

Lets be clear, this isn't flint, and thank god - it's a normal ferro ('firesteel') rod and striker. It's a bit smaller than some, but it works, the striker is good (works better than the spine of my knife)and it'll start your fires no problem if you've got halfway decent kindling.
